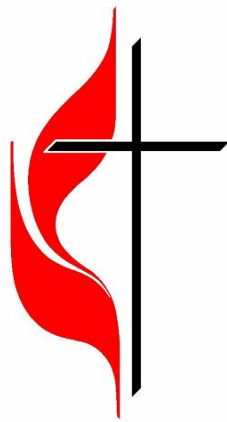
From the north or south: take M-52 to Michigan Ave.; go west on Michigan to campus.

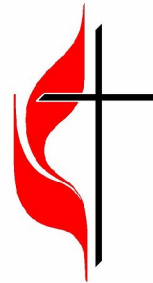
## REGISTRATION
